

Singing Eagle Lodge Packing List

Camp colors are brown (khaki is fine) and white. Camp uniform is required. There are brown and white clothes for sale at the camp store. Gently used clothing is also sold for \$1.00 per item.

All items must be marked with the camper's name.

Necessary Items:

- 14 pairs of underwear
- 14 pairs of socks
- 6-8 pairs of white, brown shorts
- 8-10 white, brown t-shirts
- 2 sweaters/sweatshirts
- 2 pairs long pants (one pair must be blue jeans)
- 1 warm jacket/vest
- 1 hooded rain jacket/poncho
- 2 pairs sneakers (one pair must have smooth soles)
- 2 sets warm pajamas
- 2-3 towels and washcloths
- 1 pair hiking boots/sturdy walking shoes
- 1 backpack
- 2 bathing suits (at least one athletic suit)
- 1 beach towel
- laundry bag
- sunscreen
- tennis racquet (correct size and weight)
- white crew hat, tennis hat, or baseball cap
- toothbrush, toothpaste
- brush, comb
- flashlight, extra batteries
- insect repellent
- water bottle
- quiet rest hour project: book, puzzle, craft
- medicines with instructions for use
- Indian dress and beads (Instructions will be mailed to new families.)

Optional Items:

- sleeping bag, pillow (While Deerwood provides sheets, pillows, and blankets, most campers choose to bring their own bedding.)
- stationery, pens, stamps
- camera, batteries/film
- musical instrument with piano accompaniment
- chapstick/lip balm
- mascot/stuffed animal
- costumes/props for plays
- cleats, shin guards
- sewing kit
- rain boots

Do not bring:

- food, candy, gum money sandals, clogs fancy clothing
- jewelry make-up electronics (iPods, cell phones, laptops, games)
